

On January 26, 2010, CBP will be enforcing the requirements for accurate and timely submission of the ISF for import ocean shipments. Your company, as the importer of record, will be facing liquidated damages of up to \$10,000 per shipment if the ISF is not compliant with the 24 hour rule prior to vessel departure.

IF YOU HAVE ELECTED P&J TO FILE ISF ON YOUR BEHALF:

- ALL of the required data elements must be received by our personnel 72 hours in advance of vessel sailing in a format that clearly identifies each element.
